## Preparation

This antibody was produced from a hybridoma resulting from the fusion of a mouse myeloma with B cells obtained from a mouse immunized with purified, recombinant Human IL-1 beta / IL1B (rh IL-1 beta / IL1B; NP\_000567.1; Met1-Ser269). The IgG fraction of the cell culture supernatant was purified by Protein A affinity chromatography.

## Formulation

 $0.2 \ \mu m$  filtered solution in PBS

#### Storage

This antibody can be stored at 2°C-8°C for one month without detectable loss of activity. Antibody products are stable for twelve months from date of receipt when stored at -20°C to -80°C. Preservative-Free.

Sodium azide is recommended to avoid contamination (final concentration 0.05%-0.1%). It is toxic to cells and should be disposed of properly. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.




