Protein lyophilized in sterile PBS (58 mM Na₂HPO₄, 17 mM NaH₂PO₄, 68 mM NaCl, 300 mM Imidazole, pH 8.0). Trehalose (5-8%) and

mannitol (5-8%) protectants were added before lyophilization.

Usage Guide

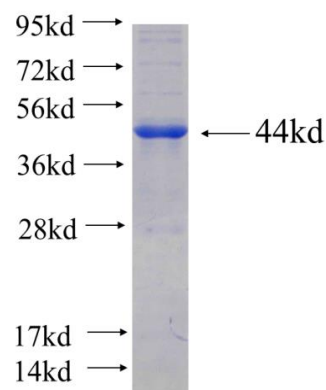
Storage:

Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Reconstitution:

Reconstitute at 0.25 µg/µl in 200 µl sterile water for short-term storage. Reconstitution with 200 µl 50% glycerol solution is recommended for longer term storage (see Stability and Storage for more details). If a different concentration is needed for your purposes please adjust the reconstitution volume as required (please note: the ion concentration of the final solution will vary according to the volume used). Note: Centrifuge vial before opening. When reconstituting, gently pipet and wash down the sides of the vial to ensure full recovery of the protein into solution.
