## **QC Testing**

#### Purity

>95% as determined by SDS-PAGE.

#### Endotoxin

 ${<}1.0$  EU per  $\mu g$  protein as determined by the LAL method.

#### Stability

Store for up to 12 months at -20°C to -80°C as lyophilized powder. Aliquots of reconstituted samples are stable at < -20°C for 3 months.

#### Formulation

Lyophilized from a 0.2  $\mu m$  filtered solution of PBS, pH7.4.

## **Usage Guide**


#### Storage

Lyophilized protein should be stored at <-20°C, though stable at room temperature for 3 weeks. Reconstituted protein solution can be stored at 4-7°C for 2-7 days.

#### Reconstitution

Always centrifuge tubes before opening. Do not mix by vortex or pipetting. It is not recommended to reconstitute to a concentration less than  $100\mu$ g/ml. Dissolve the lyophilized protein in ddH2O. Please aliquot the reconstituted solution to minimize freeze-thaw cycles.
