Stability

Store for up to 12 months at -20°C to -80°C as lyophilized powder. Aliquots of reconstituted samples are stable at < -20°C for 3 months.

Formulation

Lyophilized from a 0.2 μm filtered solution of 20mM Tris,150mM NaCl,pH8.0.

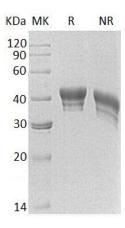
Storage

Lyophilized protein should be stored at <-20°C, though stable at room temperature for 3 weeks. Reconstituted protein solution can be stored at 4-7°C for 2-7 days.

Reconstitution

Always centrifuge tubes before opening. Do not mix by vortex or pipetting. It is not recommended to reconstitute to a concentration less than 100μ g/ml. Dissolve the lyophilized protein in ddH2O. Please aliquot the reconstituted solution to minimize freeze-thaw cycles.
