A DNA sequence encoding the C-terminal segment of human PARP3 isoform 1 (Q9Y6F1-1) (Met 1-Leu 533) was fused with the N-terminal polyhistidine-tagged GST tag at the N-terminus.

Molecular Mass

The recombinant human PARP3/GST chimera consists of 768 amino acids and has a calculated molecular mass of 87.8 kDa. It migrates as an approximately 95 kDa band in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions.

Formulation

Lyophilized from sterile 20mM Tris, 500mM NaCl, pH 8.0, 10% gly

- 1. 5 % trehalose and mannitol are added as protectants before lyophilization.

Usage Guide


Storage

Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Reconstitution

Adding sterile water, prepare a stock solution of 0.25 mg/ml. Concentration is measured by UV-Vis.
